Offshore Diving Industry Agreement – Revised Rates and Allowances – 2010-11

I am writing to give formal notification of the revised rates and allowances for the 12-month period commencing 1 November 2010. The figures – attached as Appendix to this letter - have been agreed by the RMT to whom I am also sending a copy of this letter.

The Offshore Diving Industry Agreement (ODIA) is a 3-year collective agreement between the RMT trade union and the 8 company signatories. It sets out minimum conditions for 13 prescribed disciplines, which the signatories expect the suppliers of diving personnel to apply as a minimum when working within UK territorial and Continental Shelf waters. The grading criteria, and the definitions which constitute the eligibility requirements for each discipline prescribed in the Agreement, are in accordance with the Competence Assurance and Assessment Scheme guidance published by the International Marine Contractors' Association (IMCA).

There is a strong business case for the industry to support a 'diving agreement'. It provides a degree of certainty by setting out base terms and conditions, but it also promotes flexibility as labour supply companies may supplement these. This means that any variables are focussed on company-specific priorities, requirements, branding and ethos, while core standards are guaranteed. Embedding base pay and conditions can be an effective way of supporting cost stability in the market place and for promoting the retention of skills and experience, now and in the future.

I will issue revised figures for 2011-12 during October 2011.
